SESSION 1: Aric Newhouse, SVP of Policy and Government Relations: Impact of 2016 Elections on Manufacturing

Four months into the new U.S. President's agenda, and new Congress, Aric will provide his insights through NAM, as to what it means for manufacturers in North America.

SESSION 2: Tim Roberts NASA Engineer: Emerging Technology that will Reshape How Manufacturing is Performed and its Impact on Heat Treating.

Tim Roberts is no stranger to MTI. Tim spoke at the MTI Fall Meeting in 2009. Tim will share insights that he is seeing in emerging technology that is going to create opportunity in heat treating, as well as eliminate the need for heat treating in certain processes. This is a must see session.

Dan Heath's session will be based on his book "Switch, How to Change Things When Change is Hard." The session will dig into why change is so difficult and frightening. He will present one of the greatest challenges of our personal and professional lives; how to change things when change is hard. Dan Heath is a Senior Fellow at Duke University's CASE center, which supports social entrepreneurs. At CASE he founded the Change Academy, a program designed to boost the impact of social sector leaders. Amazon.com editors named Switch one of the Best Nonfiction Books of the Year, and it spent 47 weeks on the New York Times Bestseller list.

Bermuda Amazing Race

All proceeds to benefit the Educational Foundation.

A unique and fun way to spend time exploring Bermuda. You will visit places that many visitors don't get to see and learn some fun and interesting facts about the Island.

The race is done in taxis. Each team is assigned one of 4 race routes. It is competitive, interactive and challenging, as well as good fun.

There are 4 components within the Race:

- A scavenger hunt- each team must collect specific items during the race and points are awarded for each item
- A timed race event- points are awarded for the fastest elapsed times to complete the event (staying within the 25mph speed limit of course!)
- Trivia questions- questions to be answered en route and points awarded for each correct answer
- Team challenges- pit stops along the route where teams have to complete a 'challenge'- such a golf putting or knot tying- points are awarded for completing these challenges

The object is to complete the race fully, in the shortest time possible, and arriving at the correct end location.

You will collect puzzle pieces along the way and these will fit together to give you the final destination. If you cannot solve the puzzle, there is an emergency envelope with the solution, however opening this envelope results in a large penalty.
